ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ENGLEWOOD GARDENS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, desiring to form themselves into a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Alabama, for the purposes hereinafter set forth do hereby make and subscribe their names to these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the non-profit corporation shall be the ENGLEWOOD GARDENS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. (hereinafter the "Association").

ARTICLE II -- DURATION

The period of duration of the Association shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III -- PURPOSES AND POWERS

The Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for the maintenance and preservation of ENGLEWOOD GARDENS SUBDIVISION (the "Subdivision") which may be developed, and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the owners of lots in the Subdivision, and for these purposes, the Association shall have the following powers:

- 1. The Association shall have all powers now conferred or which may hereafter be conferred upon a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Alabama which are not in conflict with the terms of these Articles.
- 2. The Association shall have all the powers and duties as contained in the By-Laws of the Association, including, but not limited to, the following:

(a) To estimate the amount of the annual budget of the Association and to make and collect assessments against owners of lots in the Subdivision.

(b) To use the proceeds of assessments in the exercise of its powers and duties.

(c) To maintain, repair, replace, sanitize and operate all Association property.

(d) To purchase insurance upon the Association property and insurance for the

protection of the Association and its members, including fidelity bond coverage for all

persons having access to the funds of the Association.

(e) To reconstruct all Association property after casualty and further improve the

property.

(f) To enforce by legal means the provisions of these Articles, the By-Laws of the

Association, and other rules and regulations of the Association.

(g) To retain legal counsel.

(h) To employ personnel to perform the services required for the proper operation

and maintenance of the Association property.

3. All funds and titles of all properties acquired by the Association and the proceeds

thereof shall be held in the name of the Association in trust for the members of the Association in

accordance with the provisions of these Articles and the By-Laws.

ARTICLE IV -- MEMBERSHIP

The Association shall issue no shares of stock of any kind or nature whatsoever. Each person

or entity who is the record owner of a lot in the Subdivision shall be a member of the Association.

There shall be one (1) member of the Association for each lot in the Subdivision. Membership shall

be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any lot. All members are subject to

assessment by the Association. The members shall enjoy such qualifications, rights and voting rights

as may be fixed in the By-Laws of the Association.

The director shall be authorized to purchase directors' and officers' liability insurance providing coverage to the officers and directors of the Association at the expense of the Association.
